



## MAGIC ORCHARD DRUGS POLICY 2015

Our policy on drugs is based around 3 key areas:

1. Prevention
2. Drug dealers and abusers
3. Welfare and treatment.

### PREVENTION

Magic Orchard's committee do not condone the dealing in or use of illegal drugs on site.

The dealing in or use of illegal drugs is not condoned.

Drug enforcement laws are as applicable at the Magic Orchard as everywhere else in the UK.

Police officers will be called onto the site and will deal with drug offences in accordance with national guidelines. If you deal in drugs, it is likely that you will be arrested.

Neither anti-social nor illegal behaviour will be tolerated and participants will leave themselves liable for eviction from the site.

If you do take drugs and you become ill, depressed or frightened please ask a steward to direct you to our Medical and welfare centre where you can receive help.

### DRUG DEALERS AND ABUSERS

Magic Orchard security will take an active role monitoring for drug dealing and will work in full co-operation with the Cumbria Constabulary.

When there is a strong suspicion of drug dealing, Magic Orchard security will inform and assist Cumbria Constabulary in every way possible. We will evict persons strongly suspected of drug dealing and wherever possible will channel these evictions via the police.

# WELFARE AND TREATMENT

Magic Orchard has door supervisors, stewards and staff that are trained in First Aid and are fully informed about the welfare facilities on site.

Our Medical and Welfare centre where we can provide an emergency response service and are on site for the whole of the Festival. The Medical and Welfare centre is situated in the event control office within the farm courtyard (where you picked up your wristband). Our highly qualified first aiders can provide care and help for those that need it.
